# FIRE AND EMERGENCY REGULATIONS

#### LEGAL PROVISIONS

Everybody is obligated to act in a way that they do not cause a fire break-out and that they contribute according to their possibilities to an adequate fulfilment of tasks in fire protection.

Especially that they provide necessary personal help in preventing and fighting a fire and other natural disasters.

### BASIC DUTIES OF THE VISITOR IN FIRE PROTECTION

- 1. To follow the "Lodging Regulations of The Cottage Dolní Morava".
- 2. Smoking and manipulation with open fire is prohibited inside the cottage! Do not throw cigarette stubs and used matches around, neither inside nor in the surroundings of the cottage.
- 3. Please take the ashes from the burnt wood outside when it is cold and throw it on the compost behind the cottage.
- 4. Look after the children so that they do not have access to matches and places with fire.
- 5. Do not store inflammable liquids in the rooms, nor in other inhabitable places.
- 6. Be very careful in the heating period.
- 7. Heaters, lights and appliances in operation must not be left without supervision.
- 8. All roads on the premises must be left freely accessible and must not be obstructed.
- 9. It is not allowed to relocate and modify heating devices.
- 10. In case of fire, the persons located on the premises are obligated to comply with the instructions of the authorities related to the fire protection.

## **DUTY TO REPORT FIRE**

- 1. Each person who notices a fire break-out is obligated to extinguish the fire immediately. If the person cannot extinguish the fire, it is her/his obligation to immediately arouse alarm and call a unit of fire protection.
- 2. The alarm is aroused by calling "HORI" (On fire!)
